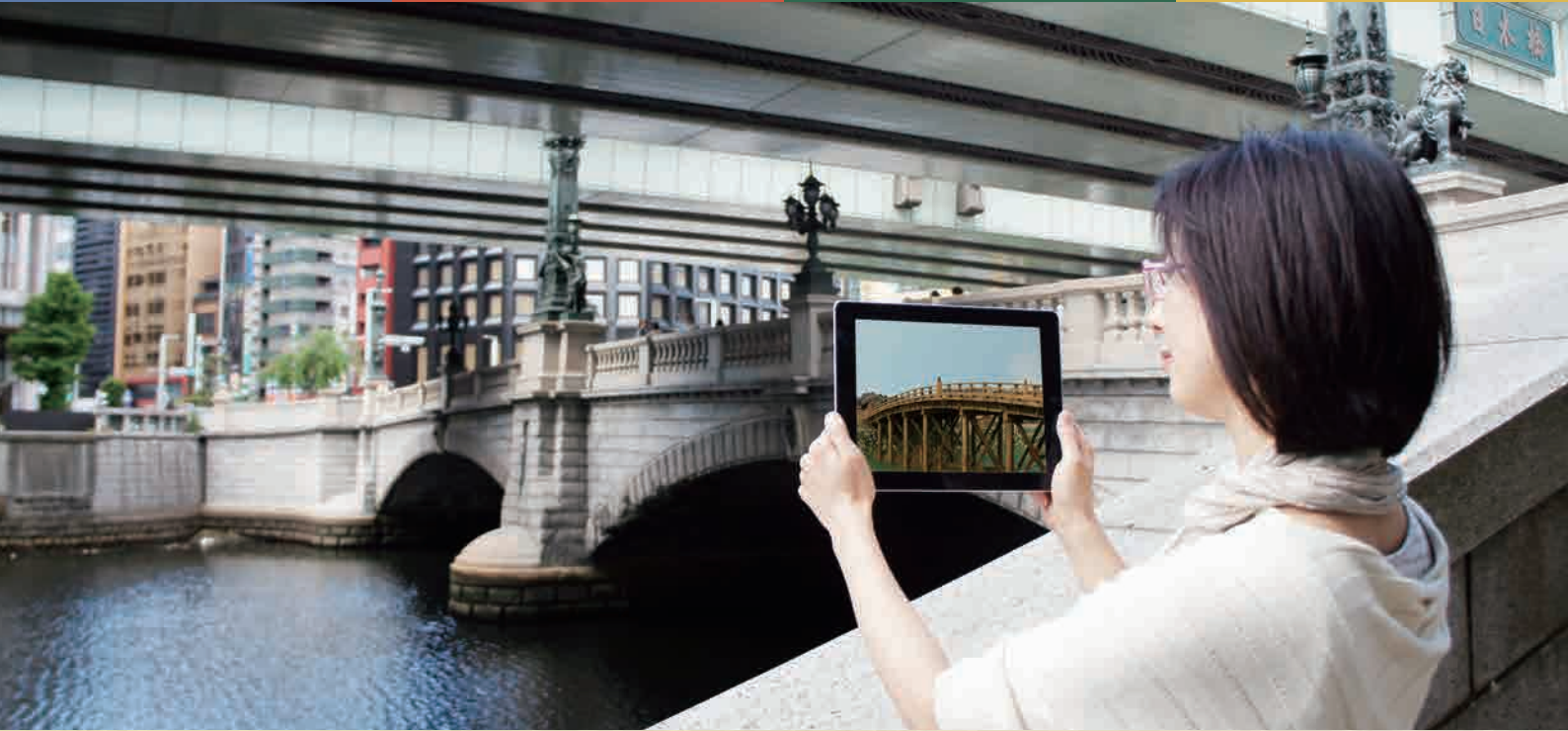

Time traveling through a telescope! Wouldn't you like to take a look back in time at your city's history?



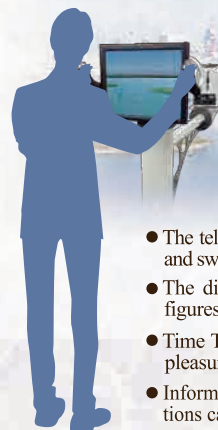
By simply looking at the telescope's monitor screen, you can view and compare the landscapes of the present and past, to utilize as a historical documentation of the city or as a guide for tourists.
